OVERVIEW

The Site (www.Pickaxecrypto.io) is operated by Pickaxe. Throughout the Site, the terms "we", "us" and "our" refer to Pickaxe. Pickaxe offers this Site, including all information, tools and services available from this Site to you, the user, conditioned upon your acceptance of all terms, conditions, policies and notices stated here.

By visiting our Site and/or purchasing something from us, you engage in our "Service" and agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions, including those additional terms and conditions and policies referenced herein and/or available by hyperlink. These Terms apply to all users of the Site, including, but not limited to, users who are browsers, vendors, customers, merchants, and/or contributors of content. Becoming a prospector grants you full ownership of your NFT and allocated server capacity for mining Ethereum and/or Bitcoin.

Pickaxe is not responsible for third party access to your wallet that results from theft or misappropriation of your account.

If anyone knowingly provides any information of a false, untrue, inaccurate or incomplete nature, Pickaxe will have sufficient grounds and rights to suspend or terminate the member in violation of this aspect of the Agreement, and as such refuse any and all current or future use of the Site or any portion thereof.

SECTION 3 – CONDUCT

As a user or member of the Site, you herein acknowledge, understand and agree that you are solely responsible for any and all content posted, uploaded, emailed, transmitted or otherwise made available by way of Pickaxe and/or the Site, and as such, we do not guarantee the accuracy, integrity or quality of such content.
